


At the heart of Borgo dei Conti Resort is its expansive spa, a sanctuary of relaxation and rejuvenation. The spa features both indoor and outdoor facilities, including a hydromassage tub, Finnish and Turkish saunas, a Sensory Deprivation area, and a Salt Room. The outdoor infinity pool, surrounded by the serene Umbrian countryside, provides a tranquil retreat, while the indoor heated pool offers a cozy alternative for relaxation. Whether lounging by the pool or indulging in a spa treatment, guests are guaranteed a unique wellness experience.





The resort's culinary offerings have quickly gained acclaim for their emphasis on fresh, local ingredients. Led by Executive Chef Emanuele Mazzella, the food and beverage program highlights the flavors of Italy through the tradition of seasonal cooking. Fine dining restaurant Cedri, located in the Villa, serves dishes made with hyper-local produce from the estate's gardens, offering a true farm-to-table experience. The all-day trattoria, L'Osteria del Borgo, transitions from Mediterranean-inspired dishes during the day to Umbrian and Ischian cuisine in the evening, providing a diverse culinary journey.



For those seeking a more casual atmosphere, the resort's lounge bar offers a stylish setting for aperitifs or post-dinner drinks. The bar, with its deep gray and brown color scheme and raw materials sourced from the region, provides a modern contrast to the historical building.





Since its opening, Borgo dei Conti Resort has become a gateway for exploring the rich cultural and natural heritage of Umbria. Located just 25 minutes from Perugia and 15 minutes from Lake Trasimeno, the resort offers easy access to some of the region's most notable attractions. Guests can enjoy private visits to the Atelier Giuditta Bronzetti Museum, dedicated to the history of weaving, or the Gialletti Giulio ceramic studio, famous for its Deruta pottery. The resort also offers unique experiences such as truffle hunting, olive oil tasting, and guided tours of local artisanal workshops.



For those looking to explore the countryside, Borgo dei Conti Resort provides pedal-assisted e-bikes and horseback riding excursions in collaboration with the Endurance Academy.
